The Hawaii Geographic Information Coordinating Council (HIGICC) is a non-profit organization interested in encouraging students to further their studies in geospatial technologies. Towards this end, HIGICC awards a \$1,000 scholarship each year to reward deserving students who show an appreciation for and understanding of geography and geographic information systems (GIS).

Eligibility Criteria and Submission Requirements

- 1) Study of geospatial technologies. Eligible students include those pursuing Associates or Baccalaureate Degrees.
- 2) Two letters of recommendation, at least one from an instructor who gave a grade to applicant.
- 3) Resume
- 4) Transcripts current to time of application (photocopies or unofficial transcripts are acceptable)
- 5) An essay, no longer than 500 words in length, describing your experience with geospatial technology, either academically, professionally, or personally, and how you hope to use geospatial data or GIS to achieve your future goals.
- 6) Please provide examples of products such as maps, analysis, screen captures of web tools, etc.
- ***Please include all application material in a single pdf document with the following naming convention:
