What a fantastic event! Thanks to everyone who attended the 2019 Hawaii Surveying and Mapping Conference which took place at Pōmaika'i Ballrooms in Honolulu on March 21st and 22nd. This first-ever joint conference between the Hawaii Geographic Information Coordinating Council (HIGICC) and Hawaii Land Surveyors Association (HLSA) was attended by nearly 300 professionals and students in the fields of GIS, geospatial technologies, and surveying.

This year's inspiring and engaging keynote speakers included Lisa Van Horn, president-elect of the National Society of Professional Surveyors; Brent Jones, Esri's Global Manager for Cadastre/Land Records; Christine Camp, president and CEO of Avalon Group, a real estate development and brokerage firm; and Susan Ballard, Chief of Police.
