Women in Geospatial+ is a professional network to promote gender-equality and diversity in the geospatial industry and academia. It's free to join! This community brings together women and other underrepresented genders in the geospatial field by providing a safe platform via Slack for open and honest communication and knowledge sharing. We put a spotlight on the achievements of women and underrepresented genders, raise awareness about the importance of diversity and empower our members to be change makers. We also launched a year- long career mentorship program last year, bringing together 42 participants from 17 countries. Our network started with a spontaneous call on Twitter one day before International Women's Day in March 2019 and has since grown into a vibrant and active community with more than 800 registered members, 3200+ followers on Twitter (@geospatialwomen) and over 900 followers on LinkedIn. Throughout the year we create opportunities to meet in person at geospatial conferences, where we regularly run sessions focused on career development. We also organize informal social events and meetups so that participants can meet each other and form new and meaningful connections.

2020 Esri User Seminar in Honolulu

On January 15, Esri hosted the 2020 User Seminar event at the Hyatt in Waikiki. Esri experts demonstrated the new capabilities of Esri technology. Participants had the opportunity to learn <u>new capabilities in ArcGIS Pro 2.5</u>, including ArcGIS Notebooks integration in ArcGIS Pro, Chart symbology for point, line, and polygon feature layers, Build Parcel Fabric tool new options, exporting workflows in Python, among other new exciting features. Participants also learn about the next generation of map making with Map Viewer Beta and the new ArcGIS StoryMap builder in ArcGIS Online. Other products included ArcGIS Indoors, ArcGIS Mission, and ArcGIS Analytics for IoT.

The afternoon workshop focused on ArcGIS Field Apps, participants had the opportunity to learn more about Esri's more popular mobile apps, followed by hands-on exercises on how to set up and configure different projects using Collector for ArcGIS, Survey 123 for ArcGIS, ArcGIS QuickCapture and Operations Dashboard for ArcGIS. This event provided a great opportunity to network with the community and learn more about new exciting products, capabilities, and solutions available to users.

2020 UAS Workshop
